Nolensville Beer Board Meeting
Date: January 9, 2014, Time 6:45 p.m.
Nolensville Town Hall, 7218 Nolensville Road

Mayor Jimmy Alexander opened the meeting at 6:45 p.m. Members present were Mayor Alexander, Aldermen Larry Felts, Beth Lothers, Jason Patrick and Brian Snyder. Staff present: Counsel Robert Notestine, Engineer Don Swartz and Recorder Cindy Lancaster. Seven citizens were in attendance.

Mr. James Stoll, owner of The Sweet Shop, 7240 Nolensville Road, Suite 301, addressed the Board noting that once a beer permit was issued he would initiate the process of constructing a kitchen at this location. He advised the Board that it would be financially difficult to install the kitchen prior to obtaining the beer permit.

It was reiterated that the beer ordinance requires 65% food sales prepared on site. With there being no kitchen this determination cannot be made. Alderman Lothers made a motion to continue this application based on the applicant meeting the requirement of principal use of 65% food requirement by the ordinance. The deferral allows The Sweet Shop to come back before the Beer Board under this application fee, Alderman Snyder seconded and this passed unanimously.

Ms. Soyoung Park and Mr. Hyun Jae Yu owners/managers and applicants of the Yuno Sushi and Asian Cuisine, located at 7715 Nolensville Road, Suite 110, were in attendance for the re-review of an on-premise beer permit.

After clarifications on beer sales Mayor Alexander made a motion to approve the beer permit, Alderman Felts seconded and this passed unanimously.
